

Making Your Own Brine Shrimp Hatcher

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This is an easy project. What is needed is two PVC 1 inch end caps, aquarium cement, 2 ½ gallon tank, stick on thermometer strip, two empty 1 liter soda bottles, air line tubing, 1 25 or 50 watt submersible heater. and a rigid section of plastic air line.

- 1: Take two empty 1 liter soda bottles and cut off the bottoms of the soda bottle.
- 2: Using aquarium cement glue each 1inch PVC end caps to the inside of the 2 ½ gallon tank. Make sure the bottles can be lined up and both can fit before you actually glue the PVC caps to the inside of the tank. Let the cement dry overnight.
- 3: Insert the aquarium heater near the bottom of the tank but not touching the soda bottles when they are inserted into the PVC end caps.
- 4: Cut the rigid plastic to a 1 foot length and attach your airline tubing to each plastic stem.
- 5: Stick on your thermometer on the tank...
